On the Questions Page, you compose the questions, tasks, and supplementary notes to support the learning outcomes expected from this lesson.

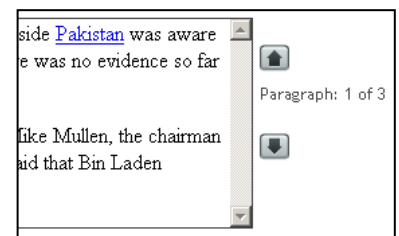
The Questions Page has three distinct parts:

- Paragraph navigation.
- Question Creation.
- Question Editing.

Follow these steps to compose questions, tasks, or notes for your lesson:

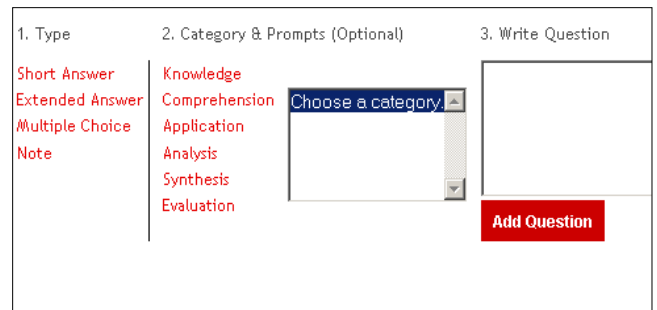
Paragraph Navigation

1. Use the up and down arrow buttons to the right of the paragraph.



Question Creation

1. Select a question type (short answer, extended, or multiple choice) or note on the left of the page.
2. Choose a category from the Bloom’s Prompts (Knowledge, Comprehension, etc.) Mouse over a category to see a description and list of related verbs.
3. Select a prompt and then modify it in the text box.
4. Click add question



Create as many questions as needed. When you are done, scroll down to the page to edit, delete, or assign questions to Differentiation Groups.

Question Editing

1. Click “Edit” to change a question or “Remove” to delete it.
